



GlaxoSmithKline Australia Award for Research Excellence

TERMS OF REFERENCE - NOMINATION

FIELD

The recipient will come from the field of human medical health.

PURPOSE

The award is to recognise an outstanding researcher with a demonstrated track record of significant work in human medical health, and for whom the award will facilitate career development and further achievements with potential importance to human medical health and Australian medical research.

CONDITIONS

- The clinician and/or scientist will not be employed by a commercial organisation.
- The work will have been carried out mainly in Australia and must demonstrate scientific credibility and merit
- The award recipient will be selected by an independent panel which will include members from the scientific and clinical community.
- The proposed nominees when shortlisted, must be available to attend the Award Ceremony which will take place in October 2012.

AWARD

- The GlaxoSmithKline Australia Award for Research Excellence Trophy to commemorate the occasion.
- \$80,000 independent research grant paid to the winner's institution to further the researcher's scientist's work and knowledge. The grant will be paid to the researcher's institution and not to the individual.
